### **Educational Qualifications and Experience**

Special Degree (Geography) 1st Class from a reputed University or 2nd Class (upper) -pass  
Post graduation will be considered as an added qualification.

**Salary Scale** Rs. 17,850/ = - 10 x 365 - 15 x 450 - 5 x 550 - Rs. 31,000/ = (Monthly) + approved allowances. Depending on the experience in the relevant field, the candidate will be placed on a suitable salary step.

**Age Limit** Should be between 18 - 45 years. The upper age limit will not apply for the officers who are in the Government to and Corporations / Statutory Boards.

### **General conditions applicable for the post**

- (1) Selected candidates should contribute 10% of their basic salary to the Employees Provident Fund, The Bureau will contribute 12 % to the EPF and 3 % to the ETR
- (2) Will be eligible for the medical and other benefits enjoyed by the staff of the Bureau.
- (3) Those who are employed in Government, Corporations / Statutory Boards should forward their applications through the respective Department Heads, but there is a provision to send a copy of the application direct.
- (4) Should furnish with the applications, Names and addresses of two non-related referees.
- (5) Photocopies of Educational and other certificates should be attached to the application.
- (6) The post applied for should be marked on the top left corner of the envelope which should be sent to the following address to be reached before 16.08.2010.
- (7) Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interviews. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification and the Geological Survey and Mines Bureau has the right to take the final decision of selecting the candidates.
